The Systemic Barriers to Economic Participation in Manitoba



Geographic Isolation

Limited access to affordable, short-term vocational training, especially outside of Winnipeg.



Financial Hurdles

Prohibitive costs of both tuition and the essential start-up equipment required to generate income.



Mentorship Gaps

A lack of professional guidance after certification, leaving graduates to navigate business launch alone.



Structural Inflexibility

The need for flexible work that accommodates caregiving responsibilities or inconsistent access to formal employment.






A Curriculum Built on a Foundation of Safety and Excellence



We Go Where We Are Needed: A Community-Based Model



1. Partnership-Driven Delivery

We actively partner with Indigenous organizations, Friendship Centres, and community employment agencies to ensure our programming is community-led, culturally relevant, and meets local needs.

2. Travel-to-Community Instruction

By delivering training directly in rural and remote communities, we eliminate prohibitive access barriers like travel costs and time away from home, strengthening local economies from within.

An Inclusive Space: Our Trauma-Informed Instructional Approach

Informed by our instructor's experience supporting residential school survivors, our program prioritizes creating a learning environment that fosters safety, trust, and empowerment.





Key Principles in Practice:

- **Safety & Predictability:**
A clear, structured schedule and transparent expectations.
- **Trust & Transparency:**
A mentorship-based relationship built on patience and respect.
- **Empowerment, Voice & Choice:**
The goal is self-efficacy and agency over one's economic future.
- **Cultural & Gender Inclusivity:**
A welcoming and respectful space for all participants.
